What's the Post-Season?

After the main season of Brackett-CSA, which ends the first week of November, Brackett Farm offers an optional Post-Season to anyone interested, which begins the second Tuesday of November and continues as long as possible.

The last several years we have been able to offer local produce throughout the winter and spring.

Although not everything we grow throughout the main season is available during the winter-to-spring Post-Season, we still try to provide as much variety as we can so no one gets too bored with their food. We are limited only by what we have to work with, which is usually quite a lot.

*Not all of these are available each week, of course. These are possibilities, depending on availability, time of the season, the weather, how cold it gets when, and what is necessary to give people what they pay for.



How Does the Post-Season Work?

The Brackett-CSA Post-Season is a mixture of CSA and Farmer's Market. It follows our CSA format in that a menu is posted each week at the regular season pick-up point which tells how much each item on the menu to take. Unlike the main season CSA, however, one does not have to buy a "block" of time. It operates on a week-by-week, cash-and-carry basis. Just bring your \$23 and take home the goodies. All I ask of people is that they tell me each week whether they are coming the following week so I know how many to plan for.

When Does the Post-Season Start?

The Brackett-CSA Post-Season begins Tuesday, November 14^h, 2023. Pickups are on Tuesdays from 4-7 PM at the garage behind our house at 611 W. Union Street in Champaign.
